Re: Update for DCAMM Site Assessment/Feasibility Study for Hampden County Courthouse Relocation

Dear Judge Payne,

In accordance with Paragraph 5 of the Settlement Agreement executed on or about May 6, 2022 in the case captioned *Coakley-Rivera, et al. v. Carey, et al.*, Case No. SJ-2021-0355, the Division of Capital Asset Management and Maintenance ("DCAMM") provides the following monthly progress update on the site assessment and feasibility study referenced therein.

Since its last update on June 6, 2022, DCAMM and its consultants have worked to finalize a comprehensive set of selection criteria for sites that could serve as the location for a new courthouse. We expect the selection criteria to be finalized within the next two weeks. Barring any unforeseen delays, DCAMM anticipates the space needs analysis for a new courthouse will also be complete within the next two to three weeks. Completion of these tasks will allow the site assessment and feasibility study to move forward into the next phase of developing a long list of potential sites and eventual site selection.
